
# HER CLIMB MEDIA KIT 2026

Her Climb is a free multi-year leadership and college access program for high school girls from underserved communities.

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ORGANIZATIONAL OVERVIEW



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Her Climb prepares high school girls to step into new spaces with confidence, skill, and community. We begin with rising sophomores at our partner public schools and stay with them through college and early career stages. Our model blends leadership development, wellness, industry exposure, and sustained mentorship.

We serve girls who have talent, ambition, and drive but limited access to structured guidance or professional networks. Her Climb offers a clear path forward and a community that travels with them.

Our program is distinct because it is long term, high touch, and rooted in relationships. Girls do not cycle in and out of isolated opportunities. They advance together and grow through a shared structure that supports their ambitions year after year.

Demand for the program continues to rise as schools and families seek models that combine rigor with care.

#### **OUR FOUNDER**



**Rita Omokha** created Her Climb to give girls what she once needed: direction, community, and the chance to belong in rooms where power and opportunity circulate. As a first-generation immigrant and graduate of Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism, where she graduated top of her class and is now an adjunct professor, she understands both the barriers and the possibilities.

She is an award-winning journalist and author whose work centers on young people, education, and civic agency. Her reporting and teaching reflect a deep belief in what girls can accomplish when they are supported with intention.

#### **PROGRAM SNAPSHOT**

#### <u>Summer Intensive</u>

A three-week experience where rising sophomores select one of four tracks: Business, Creative Arts, Journalism, or STEM. Students complete hands-on capstones, meet industry professionals, and begin building a supportive cohort.

#### Year-Round Programming

Weekly Saturday workshops, wellness sessions, academic checkins, retreats, and enrichment activities that strengthen leadership skills and deepen community ties.

#### Four Tracks

#### Business, Creative Arts, Journalism, and STEM.

Each reflects a pathway where girls have often been underestimated and underrepresented.

#### **Our Pillars**

#### Leadership. Access. Wellness. Sisterhood.

These principles guide every decision, partnership, and interaction.

A typical student experience includes project-based learning, mentorship, cultural and sports enrichment, and opportunities to lead.

# ACCESS WEEKEND + NATIONAL EXPANSION

Access Weekend brings Her Climb's model to public schools with limited resources through a two-day immersion that blends leadership workshops, wellness programming, and early college exposure. Schools receive a five-thousand-dollar Access and Wellness Grant to support their students beyond the weekend.

This initiative marks the start of Her Climb's national expansion. It introduces the program to new regions, strengthens school partnerships, and identifies girls who would benefit from sustained support and access.
